When you know the recipient and address him/her by name (like Dear ABC), then you use "Yours sincerely". Whereas "Yours faithfully" is used when the recipient is not addressed by name (like "Dear Sir/Madam") or when the recipient is not known personally by the sender.

Which one is correct, "yours faithfully", or "yours ...

The Quick Answer Letters that start "Dear Sir," should end "Yours truly" (US convention) or "Yours faithfully" (UK convention). Letters that start with a name (e.g., "Dear Mr. Jones"), should end "Sincerely yours" (US convention) or "Yours sincerely" (UK convention).

Yours sincerely | Yours truly | Yours faithfully

The expression yours faithfully is used at the end of formal letters, when the name of the recipient of not known. If you are writing to someone but you only know his or her gender, you can address them as Dear Sir or Dear Madam. The correct complimentary close, in this case, would be 'yours faithfully' followed by your initials and surname.
